Dear Parents/Carers,

With school having returned for two weeks I wanted to write to you to welcome everyone back after what has been another successful year for our pupils in their GCSEs. In almost all areas, pupils' results improved on last year's impressive performance, despite the increased challenge of the new GCSE. The results will be published on our website when the official publication from the Department of Education are released in a few months' time. We will celebrate the Class 2018's achievements at our annual prize night on 22nd November.

The school's Open Evening for parents and children of Year 5 and 6, will take place on **Tuesday, 25th September.** To allow staff to prepare the school in time, school will close for pupils at lunch time (which is **11.40am** on a Tuesday). School buses have been ordered for this time. Any pupil returning to assist for the Open Evening will be given a letter for parents/carers to sign and must be in full school uniform.

They will be taking part in a team building exercise later this month and their induction period will end with a Mass of Welcome in school on Tuesday, 9th October.
