Dear Parents and Carers

We are now able to confirm that the results for GCSE and BTEC will be sent to pupils as planned tomorrow. Pupils will receive their result by their school email after 8.00am and this will be followed with a 'hard copy' of the results in the post to the address we have on the school's system.

The results pupils are receiving are the highest grade of either the Centre Assessed Grade (CAG) or the moderated grade of the exam board. No pupil grades have been lowered.

We have been informed that the final result for the Cambridge National in PE will not be available until Tuesday, 25th September and therefore the grade these pupils will receive is the CAG. We will send the final grade for this course via email when we receive them.

We have raised a query with some of the BTEC grades in some subjects and we have now been told that these will be reviewed by Tuesday, 25th September. I can only apologise for any further frustration this delay will cause to pupils and parents. Again, we will inform these pupils via email of the outcome of this enquiry.

Finally, I want send every best wishes to all our Year 11 pupils. I hope they are pleased with their grades, which they worked very hard to achieve and that their results allow them to continue successfully with the stage of their life. As a year group, they have had to endure an incredibly challenging six months and missed so much of their final experience of school, which is a sadness to us all.
