# **Lateral Flow Device (LFD) Testing for the start of the Autumn Term**

If you have given permission for your child to undertake 2 lateral flow device tests at the start of the Autumn Term please see below.

Please ensure that your child is aware that you have given permission for them to undertake the tests.

Pupils will return to class upon completion of each test.

Pupils and parents will be informed of any positive test outcome. Pupils with a positive LFD test result should self-isolate in line with NHS guidance and will also need to undertake a PCR test. Whilst awaiting the PCR result, the pupil should continue to self-isolate.

If the PCR test is taken within 2 days of the positive LFD, and is negative, it overrides the self-test LFD test and the pupil can return to school, as long as they do not have any COVID-19 symptoms.



# **Timetable**

All pupils, regardless of whether they are undertaking an LFD test or not, should report to school no later than 8.15am on the days stipulated below. Pupils should follow their normal timetable and be collected when it is time for their test. If pupils are late for school, they will have to attend lunch-time detention.

### Uniform

### A reminder of some important uniform issues:

Wear correct uniform

If you arrive to school without shoes you will be expected to wear a pair provided by school

Coats must be black or navy blue

No jewellery is allowed

All piercings, will need to be removed before a pupil sets off for school. Over the summer please consider that pupil cannot wear piercings

If a pupil is seen with a mobile phone(or it is heard to ring or emit a message) on school premises they will have it confiscated until a parent/carer makes an arrangement to have it collected. In normal circumstances this will be a written note brought in by the pupil the next day.

Pupils must bring full and correct kit for PE or they will be expected to wear clean school PE kit provided by school

Hair must be one natural colour

We do not allow extreme haircuts

Pop and energy drinks are not allowed in school

Skirts must not be rolled up at the waist and must be worn to just above the knee

Equipment – Pupils will be provided with basic equipment on the first day but will then be expected to always have these each day
