What is the conscience?

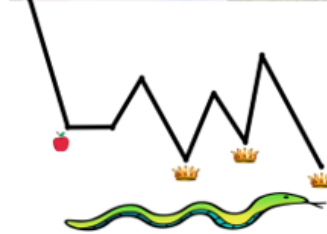
The conscience is the voice of God that leads you on the right path.

The conscience leads you to Natural Law.

As humans are infected with Original Sin, we have the tendency to want to go against our conscience and sin.



What is sin?



Personal sin - This is the sin for which an individual is **personally responsible**. People's free choices can lead them to **make bad decisions** that cause pain and suffering.

Original sin - Catholics believe humans are born in a state of original sin, **inheriting** all the consequences of **Adam and Eve's sin**. This means that every person is **inclined, or tempted, to do what they want** rather than following God's teaching and being obedient to God's laws.

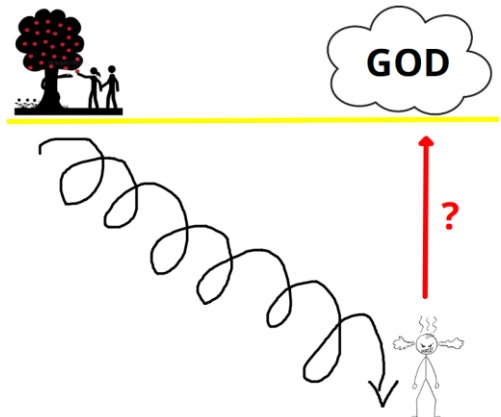
What is the rescue plan?

The Covenant at Sinai

- 1) Thou shall not worship any other Gods before me.
- 2) Thou shall not worship any other idols.
- 3) Thou shall not take the Lord's name in vain.
- 4) Remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy.
- 5) Honour thy Father and Mother.
- 6) Thou shall not kill.
- 7) Thou shall not commit adultery.
- 8) Thou shall not steal.
- 9) Thou shall not bear false witness against your neighbour.
- 10) Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's possessions
