Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium 2020/21

In 2020 - 21, it is proposed that the Catch Up Premium funding will be used to further enhance learning and improve pupil alongside the Covid Catch-up funding. Due to the lack of KS2 scores, pupils have been identified through ongoing teacher assessments.

- Using HLTAs to support the learning of catch-up students by using various intervention strategies and/or to supply cover for the class teacher.
- Pupils identified have been involved in the NTP small group support in English and maths.
- Additional in class support as required.
- Pupils allocated places in the Foundation School.

LITERACY

Rationale: To raise the Literacy levels of pupils below the expected level of attainment prior to Year 7 entry

- Raising the profile of literacy across the curriculum
- Literacy Co-coordinator

NUMERACY

Rationale: To raise the numeracy levels of pupils below the expected level of attainment prior to Year 7 entry

- Smaller class sizes for lower ability pupils with HLTA support when necessary.
- HLTA support and interventions

This will be reviewed when funding has been confirmed and allocated.
