Section A: Blood Brothers

You will be given the choice between two questions. Choose one then write an essay about that question. Revise characters and themes, linking them to Russell's intentions overall.

Section B: Power and Conflict Anthology

You will be given a poem from the anthology you have studied and you will be asked to compare the ways in which poets present ideas about a theme relating to power or/and conflict. You choose the other poem to compare it to.

Section C: Unseen Poetry

In this section there are two questions.

- The first gives you one poem and asks you to write an essay exploring how the poet presents the idea in the question.
- The second gives you another poem and asks you to compare how the poets use methods to present the linked theme.
