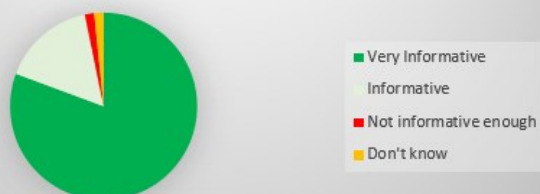
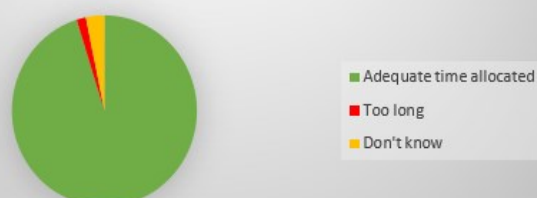


Overall, how informative did you find the Y9 Options Evening was to prepare your child for choosing their options?
